OCRWC Qualification Rules

- Anyone wishing to qualify for the 2018 OCRWC at the April Reaper must be registered for the Elite Timed wave, either day or night.
- Your race number must be clearly visible at all times whilst on the course (we recommend writing your number on your arm/forehead in addition to the numbered bib issued).
- Each runner will be issued with 3 coloured wrist bands. These must be worn throughout the event and must be clearly visible, not hidden under clothing.
- ALL obstacles will be compulsory. All but the finishing series will be in the main body of the course.
- Failure of a compulsory obstacle will result in the loss of a band.
- Between the penultimate and the final compulsory obstacles you will have the opportunity to 'win back' lost bands. One weighted lap of the lake will win you back 1 band, 2 laps = 2 bands. You can win back a maximum of only 2 bands.
- After the final compulsory obstacle you will NOT have the opportunity to win back further bands.
- Obstacles may be attempted an unlimited number of times.
- There are NO preferential or retry lanes. Do not queue jump, this will be viewed as obstacle failure and you will lose a band.
- Anyone found 'shortening the course' will be deemed unsportsmanlike and will be excluded from qualification. Follow the course between tapes at all times.
- Any runner preventing a marshal from removing a band for failing an obstacle will be excluded from qualification.
- Finishers will be classified as follows:
 - Finishing with 3 bands - Fastest to slowest
 - Finishing with 2 bands - Fastest to slowest
 - Finishing with 1 band - Fastest to slowest
 - Finishing without a band - fastest to slowest
- The top 10 women and top 10 men in each of the day and night races will qualify for their OCRWC age category.
- The top 3 women and top 3 men in each of the day and night races will receive Pro Qualification for the OCRWC.
- Any dispute regarding your finishing status must be lodged with the Race Director within 1 hour of you finishing the race.
- After reviewing all the available facts the decision of the Race Director will be full and final.
